Racehorse Welfare Project

To develop racehorse relevant welfare measures through a collaborative, co-construction process with racehorse industry stakeholders. Potential new measures will be developed, tested and re-evaluated by stakeholder groups and then integrated with existing relevant measures to form a robust, industry relevant racehorse welfare assessment tool.

Collect and analyse baseline racehorse welfare data across a representative sample of racing yards in across the UK.
